1	Upon consideration of Plaintiffs' Motion for Class Certification, the parties' briefing,		
2	and oral argument, if any, this Court finds that Plaintiffs have satisfied the requirements for		
3	class certification under Fed. R. Civ. P. 23(a) and (b)(2). Specifically, Plaintiffs have		
5	demonstrated that members of the proposed class are so numerous that joinder is impracticable;		
6	that there are questions of law and fact common to the class; that the claims of the Plaintiffs are		
7	typical of the claims of the class members; and that Plaintiffs and their counsel, as		
8	representatives of the class, will fairly and adequately protect its interests. Additionally, this		
9	Court finds that Defendants have acted on grounds generally applicable to the class in its		
10	entirety, thereby making appropriate final injunctive and declaratory relief for all class		
11	members.
